Press Release: Update on the COVID-19 Government Guidance for places of worship

السلام عليكم ورحمة الله

Following the announcement from the Prime Minister on 22nd September to limit the spread of COVID-19, certain changes have been made. Though places of worship, businesses and schools (including Madrassahs) can remain open with the ongoing measures. The number of attendees at a marriage ceremony will be reduced from 30 to 15 from 28th September. Funerals must have no more than 30 people attending. The NHS COVID-19 app has launched on 24th September, venue managers for Places of worship are strongly recommended to display a QR poster to enable worshippers to check-in. Those who have checked in via the app do not need to be asked for their contact details on entry.
